MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING, DECEMBER 5, 2022

1. CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Vice-Chair Wais. Present were Committee members Cardwell and Currington.

Also, the property on 2nd and Wanda needs to be reviewed as the public sidewalks are unavailable.
